Terms & Conditions

1. The event is run by Animeleague LTD registered at 609 Fishponds Road, Bristol, BS16 3AA. Animeleague LTD henceforth shall be referred to as Animeleague in this document.

2. By applying for tables for the event, you agree to abide by these terms and conditions. Animeleague reserve the right to alter these terms and conditions at any point in the future without any notice. If these terms are altered, we will inform you of any changes if you are booked in for an event where the new terms will go into effect for you.

3. Animeleague reserves the right to cancel any booking anytime for any reason. If your booking is cancelled and you have already paid, then you will be issued a full refund including the deposit.

4. You acknowledge that while Animeleague does its best to ensure attendance, Animeleague can't guarantee footfall and will not be held responsible if attendance is lower than expected. Refunds after an event are not usually possible, and are given at the discretion of Animeleague.

5. Bookings made more than eight weeks in advance of an event are required to pay a non-refundable deposit of 15% of your booking total (rounded to the nearest whole pound). This need to be paid within seven days (one calendar week) to secure the booking. Bookings with unpaid deposits will be automatically cancelled after seven days. You are required to pay the full amount no later than 8 weeks prior to the event, after which your booking may be cancelled and you won't be eligible for a refund on your deposit. We may sometimes allow later payment, but this must be agreed with Animeleague beforehand.

6. Bookings made within eight weeks of an event are required to pay the full amount within three working days of being invoiced to secure the booking. If you do not pay during this time your booking may be removed. Animeleague may sometimes allow later payment, but this must be agreed beforehand.

7. You are entitled to a full refund minus the non-refundable deposit up to eight weeks prior to the event. Any refunds thereafter are at the discretion of Animeleague and will not include the non-refundable deposit amount of 15%.

8. You are responsible for the security and insurance of your stock and for your own public liability insurance. Animeleague agree to provide secure storage during hours when the dealers room is closed.

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9. You agree to not sell bootleg items. These are items which are fakes of officially licensed products in this country; please see Animeleague's [Bootlegs Guide](#) for full information on what is and what is not acceptable.

10. Anything you sell must be legal within this country. Food and drink sales please enquire with Animeleague first before bringing as this depends on the venue. You will require any relevant certificates such as food hygiene if selling food. Real weapons, even blunted or even fakes made from metal, cannot be sold due to security issues. If you are selling replica weapons, you must check if they are okay to be sold with us via email beforehand. Anything adult in nature such as hentai, must not be in public display.

11. Your stall must be no more than 8ft (2.5m) in height. DIY style frameworks and stands will not be permitted. For this purpose, what is being classed as a DIY style framework is anything that requires power tools, hammer & nails etc. to assemble. Any structures you use have to be purpose built and connecting pieces should be able to be locked together with bolts, or securely fit together such as push-assembly stands and frames. Erected structures should be secure and not liable to wobble, move or fall over. Animeleague reserve the right to ask you to remove any structure if it is deemed to be unsafe for use.

12. If a customer requests a refund on the day of the event, then you will be required to provide it provided the product is being returned in similar condition. If the customer believes it is a bootleg or flawed and reasonable proof is not shown that it is not, then you'll be required to give a refund regardless. This applies within 28 days of the event, under standard trading laws, if the customer gets in contact with Animeleague.

13. You will be required to remove any stock that Animeleague believes to be bootleg, illegitimate or mis-sold, unless you can provide evidence that it is legitimate.

14. If you break bootlegs policy or the convention rules, or any terms laid out here then Animeleague reserve the right to remove you from the event at any time.

15. The table space you buy is the exact space in width you are allocated, with approx. 3ft of space behind the table. If you require extra space width to the side of your stall for stands, you must ask this upon booking and there may be an extra charge depending on how much space is required. If you require extra space behind the table then you must purchase backing space, which is an extra table behind your stand, or the equivalent space instead. This will add an extra 2.5ft approx. of space behind your tables.

16. You agree to abide by our [Event Terms & Conditions](#) that apply to everyone in attendance. Note for Alcon, a separate [Alcon Terms & Conditions](#) applies instead, as Alcon is an 18+ event.

17. If you break any of these terms, then Animeleague will typically provide you with one warning. If this is ignored, then Animeleague reserves the right to remove you from the event with no compensation or refund. In more serious cases you will be removed immediately with no warning, compensation or refund.
